BLESSING BAGS BRING HOPE: NOURISHING THE MALNOURISHED

A **Rice and Soy Blessing Bag** is not just a meal, it's a hope-filled, life-changing source of nutrients. While in Guatemala, we met with a doctor at a local clinic that distributes Midwest Mission Blessing Bags. Their clinic sees a high number of children come in who are malnourished

"The Rice and Soy meals are quite nutritious food, rich in protein," the doctor commented. "We focus on families. They get around 30 Blessing Bags to last them the month. They get creative with culinary arts – they add chicken, add eggs to make it into a casserole, mash it down into cakes, or even blend it into drinks!"

Rice is the nutritional base of the diet in Guatemala. If a family doesn't have to buy rice because they are given Blessing Bags, then they are able to use that money to add more protein to their meal by buying chicken or other meat. These meals help malnourished children heal, while the clinic teaches families about nutrition, and helps guide them towards a more sustainably healthy future.
