Wilderness Trip Presentation: At the end of worship this weekend, our Wilderness Team will share meaningful faith-building moments from our July trip to Glacier National Park in Montana. We are so thankful for the support of Grace members so we can experience God's awesome love in creation and people with us. We couldn't do this without you!

Fall Bible Study

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to walk in the places that Jesus did? If you have, this bible study is for you! This fall, we will be exploring this bible study, **“In the Footsteps of the Savior: Following Jesus Through the Holy Land.”** The author, Pastor Max Lucado shares key teachings from the Gospels and Acts on the people and places that shaped Jesus' life. Filmed entirely in the Holy Land, Max guides you through events that took place in Israel, weaving together lessons from the impact of following Jesus:

- **Capernaum:** following Jesus when you doubt
- **Sea of Galilee:** following Jesus in your storms
- **Mount of Beatitudes:** following Jesus when you worry
- **Temple Steps:** following Jesus...and only Jesus
- **Garden Tomb:** following Jesus when you need hope
- **Caesarea:** following Jesus when you need grace

As you see these places where Jesus actually walked and ministered, you will deepen your connection with the King of the universe who became the Savior on the cross (Study Gateway at <https://www.studygateway.com>).

We will meet Mondays at 11:00 am for 6 weeks, Sept. 21- Oct. 26* in the Grace sanctuary.
