Pastor's Pondering – August 2025

I have the privilege of being chosen to be a part of a Missional Leadership Cohort this year and I'd like to give you an overview of why this is important to me (and Grace!) Sponsored by a generous Siebert Foundation and facilitated through Luther Seminary, this workshop covers costs for resources, monthly coaching meetings, and 3 retreats during the year. It has given me a chance to connect with colleagues, sharing ideas and resources for leading a faith community.

Our focus is on innovation in faith. Looking for creative and purposeful ways to join God at work in the world around us. That means looking at where the needs are at Grace and where we need to adapt to meet those needs. Involving Grace members and getting your input is important.



We can collaborate on ideas to try in what we call a "holy experiment." We will try an experiment and get feedback on how it met the needs we identified. We can learn from our successes and our failures. The most important thing is listening to the Holy Spirit and remembering our mission of Praising God + Building Relationships + Serving Others + Growing Faith.

I will be sharing more as we move into this process. I ask for your prayers and support for Grace in listening, learning and acting in innovative ways. I look forward to seeing where God is at work at Grace!

August Newsletter – Pastor Kathy

It's been 5 years last month since Jon and I moved up to Wisconsin's Northwoods. We came to rural Rhinelander and Hilts Lake to fulfill a promise to my parents; a promise made to help them feel comfortable leaving their retirement home on the lake for an independent living facility in Hudson, nearer to my brother.

It takes both energy and time to adjust to living in a new location. Even though we spent time visiting my parents over the years there were shops and repair places to be located, doctors, dentists, hair stylists to be found, and favorite restaurants to be determined. There was also the need for us to find a place to worship. These efforts were all made difficult because we moved in the first year of COVID.

The apostle Paul knew well the challenges of entering new communities. Some were far more welcoming than others! What is often missed is that following his 'seeing the light' on the way to Damascus, and his time learning from Ananias, he traveled through Jerusalem and Caesarea to Tarsus and spent three years there. We do not know who welcomed him there – though it was his hometown, but it was here he learned more about Jesus; his story, his ministry, and the meaning and importance of his death and resurrection. He came to see Jesus as more than 'a Messiah', he was 'the Promised Messiah, the Son of God'.

When Jon and I arrived at Grace — Tomahawk in August, 2020, we came to discern membership in this faith community. Soon after, I was asked to serve alongside Pastor Check and Pastor Susan, to fill weekly preaching needs until a new 'settled' Pastor was found. We became members once worship returned live in the sanctuary each week. In the fall of 2023, a year after Pastor Julie was installed, I was offered the opportunity to provide visitation services to members and four care facility worship services per month as a 'retired Pastor'. September 1, after two years, I will be formally ending my visitation contract. We continue to be members, and hope to remain involved in various ministries at Grace. It is my prayer that Grace will continue to welcome those looking for a faith community and look intentionally for ways to gather us in and make us one. Grace and all of you remain in my prayers.




