With the gap in SNAP benefits affecting so many, including seniors, food scarcity is on our hearts and minds as November continues. **Grace Cares** about its members and all who are affiliated with Grace Lutheran – we would like to help! To get us started, an anonymous family is donating \$200 in Trigs, Kwik Trip and Walmart gift cards, a portion of which will be available to any member who comes to the

church office during office hours and asks. Shelf stable food items will also be available on a 'food table' for members to GIVE what you can or TAKE what you need.

If you are able and feel called, please donate either gift cards or non-perishable food items this week during office hours. Any gift cards left over following this crisis will be kept for the Pastor's discretion fund. Food will be available here or at the food pantry.

### FAIR TRADE FOR THE HOLIDAYS

We've received a fresh batch of Fair Trade products in time for the holidays. Gift baskets are available for purchase or you can place a special order, with order forms available in the church office. We thank you for your support of this valuable ministry – a way to support farmers around the world who may not otherwise have access to fair compensation for their products. Remember, this is not a fundraiser and the products are sold at or below our cost. And Margie makes beautiful gift baskets!

The Annual Cookie Walk and Craft Sale will be held on Saturday, Dec. 13th at 9 am for Craft area and 9:30 am for Cookie Walk until noon or sold out. Crafts will use the Gathering area and Cookie Walk will be in Fellowship Hall. Lefse will also be made and sold again this year but only for our congregation (unless there is extra, and it will be sold at Cookie Walk). This year funds raised will be for debt retirement, Plexiglas for confirmation pictures in kitchen hallway, and Blessing for Babies project.

**Lefse will be made on Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 8th & 9th .** Sign-up sheets are out for purchasing ingredients and placing orders. NEW THIS YEAR we will require you to pay for your order before picking it up. This will hopefully eliminate the problems in previous years with orders made and never picked up. Price remains \$6 per package of 3 lefse with a limit of 10 packages per family. Envelopes are out for you to use in making your payment to the church office or in the offering plate. Please have exact amount due. Note that lefse must be picked up by Sunday service Dec. 14th . Remember training is provided for anyone interested in learning about this tradition at Grace. ALSO NEW this year, we will be ricing our own potatoes with equipment of our own.

**Crafts can be dropped off Friday, Dec. 12th** between 8 am & 6 pm or earlier in week by leaving your craft item in the hallway by the office and filling out the provided craft form. This form provides us with your name, items, and whether you would like them back or not if the item does not sell. After the Saturday event crafts will be sold ½ hour before and after weekend services.

Calling all COOKIE BAKERS! Please consider providing 1 or 2 batches of your favorite Christmas cookie or sweet treat (fudge, candy, or bread). Cookie price will remain the same at \$8.50 per pound with varying prices on other treats. Drop off is welcome on Friday, Dec. 12th between 8 am and 6 pm and please deliver them to kitchen. Remember to package Well for overnight storage in airtight containers with your name on them. Also label your cookies/candies with their name (Turtles, Coconut balls, etc.), and if they contain nuts or if they are gluten free.

It is a way to share in a unique ministry, caring for those in Tomahawk and the surrounding area – being the face of Jesus by loving your neighbor or working behind the scenes.


